[The Church Street Tavern](#) is a warm, cozy pub that's perfect for a rainy day or a winter night. Tones of brick and bronze come together to set the mood of old fashioned comfort in this relatively new bar. The fare is what you would expect from a tavern, albeit a slightly expensive tavern (this is Tribeca, after all.) The menu boasts New York's best new burger and Happy Hour, (Mon-Fri, 5-7) features oysters at \$1 a pop and pints for \$4.
